- Practice low impact/no trace land use and provide wildlife interpretation.
- Handle complaints and prevent legislation violations.

Requirements

- Minimum two seasons of whitewater paddling in either kayak, canoe, or raft.
- Current criminal record check w/vulnerable sector
- Must have 2 previous seasons experience of guiding / instructing guests in moving water
- Swiftwater Rescue Certificate. *
- First Aid and CPR Certificate. *
